Shannon McNamara was born on June 21, 1979 and became an angel on June 12, 2001. It was because she chose to physically fight back that her killer was caught. He was taken to trial in February 2003, and was found guilty on all counts of home invasion, aggravated criminal sexual assault and first-degree murder. Two weeks later, the state of Illinois sentenced him to death. Today he sits on Illinois death row awaiting execution. In 2001, Shannon's friend, Erin Weed, founded Fight Back Productions in response to this tragic murder. With this new, harsh reality of violence fresh in her memory, Erin abandoned her career as a New York City television producer to study with the best violence prevention, personal safety and self-defense experts in the world. In 2002 Erin began speaking professionally and has since published a book, appeared in national news media, won many awards and trained a team of speakers based around the United States to get the message out that **we are all worth fighting for!**

Statistics that may surprise you... (courtesy of Bureau of Justice Statistics)

- ★ The Violence Against Women Act of 1994 mandated the study of campus victimization.
- ★ Males experienced higher victimization rates than females for all types of violent crime except rape/sexual assault.
- ★ About 7 in 10 female rape or sexual assault victims stated the offender was an intimate, other relative, a friend or an acquaintance.
- ★ In 2007, **10%** of male students and **5%** of female students reported experiencing a threat or injury with a weapon on school property. **90%** of campus crime is student on student.
